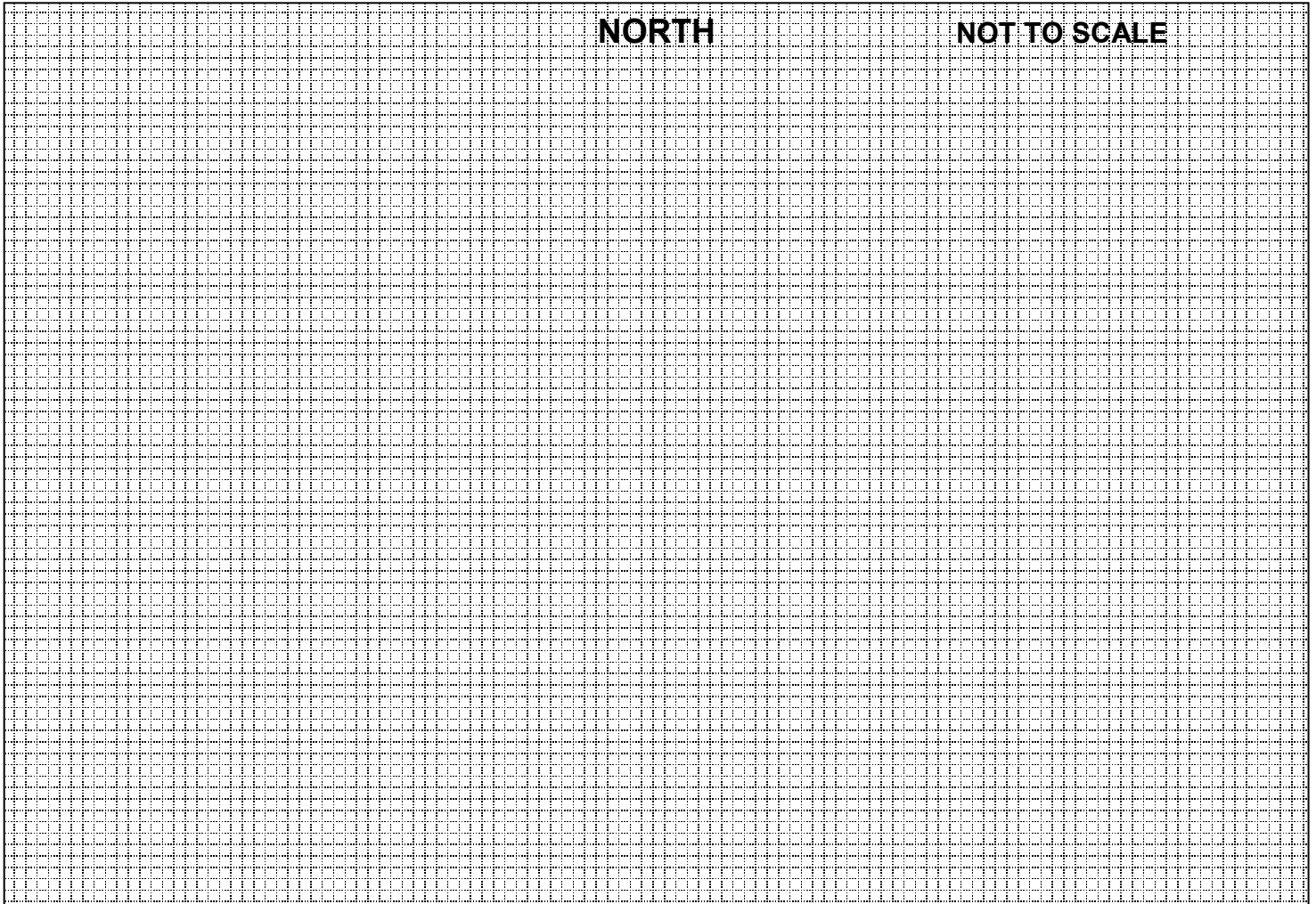

Note that such loads as garbage disposals, water softening discharge and excessive water use are not recommended and will shorten system life. Since conditions may change with time and system use, you are advised to have the systems evaluated regularly to determine their condition and function. The owner/tenant of this property have full responsibility for the future upkeep, maintenance, and repair of these systems. Maintenance is not the responsibility of the Health Department.
2. Drinking water sample analysis is limited to specific bacteriologic indicator organisms and the specific chemical(s) listed. Water sample test results indicate neither the presence nor absence of any other environmental pollutants.
