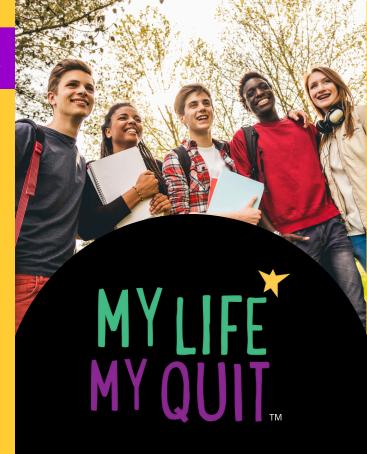
Quit Coaches
