Harm Reduction provides practical tools, education, and support to help people living with substance use disorder stay safer and healthier. Our approach is simple but powerful: we meet people where they are — both literally and figuratively — and provide services without judgment to reduce the risks of overdose, infectious disease, and other related harms.

Services Include:

- Overdose prevention education and naloxone distribution
- Safer use supplies and health information
- HIV and hepatitis C prevention education and referrals
- Connections to treatment, healthcare, housing, and social services
- Peer support and community resource navigation

Our goal is to save lives, improve health outcomes, and strengthen our community by expanding access to care and support. Harm Reduction recognizes that every life has value, and that keeping people safe and healthy creates more opportunities for healing, stability, and recovery.
